

# **The Updating Process for the Australian Ranking of ICT Conferences**

## **Management**

The Australian ranking of ICT Conferences will reside on the public website of CORE (COmputing Research and Education) - [www.core.edu.au](http://www.core.edu.au). Updates will be evaluated at the annual meeting of the Heads and Professors of Computing held at Australasian Computer Science Week, approximately the end of January each year.

## **Template**

On the CORE website is a ranking template in both word document and html format. To assist members determine an appropriate ranking for a new conference or to change the existing ranking of a conference, the website also contains a pdf of the tiers used in the ranking system and a pdf of a sample update argument.

## **Process**

After filling in the template, please email it to [conference.rankings@core.edu.au](mailto:conference.rankings@core.edu.au).

The deadline will be 31 December each year. All update emails will be gathered, analysed for duplicates, etc and then sent to the Heads and Professors before their meeting. When the suggested updates have been evaluated by this meeting, the changes will be made to the master online list with a date attached.

Please note that we are aware that some of these conferences no longer exist or have changed their names. As one of the purposes of the list is to assist appointments/promotions committees, it was felt necessary to keep a historical record.
